### Description:

Scarce view of the City of Novogorod, which appeared in Vander Aa's *Galerie Agreeable*.

A fine view of the city, with the Volkhov River in the foreground and a bridge crossing the river, with fortified walls shown.

At its peak during the 14th century, the city was the capital of the Novgorod Republic and one of Europe's largest cities.

The town is shown at about the time that Novgorod was made the administrative center of Novgorod Governorate of the Russian Empire (in 1727), which was detached from Saint Petersburg Governorate.
