

## **Description:**

Engraved sea chart covering the area from Cape Blanco, Costa Rica, to the mouth of the Gulf of Mexico, with an inset map titled "Continuation of the Gulf of California, from Mazatlan to Port Guymas." The map includes the following harbor map insets: "Guymas", "Mazatlan", "Port San Blas", "The Port of Acapulco", "Acamama or Palizada Road", and "A Plan of Realejo".

The map was first issued in 1828, however, the present example has been updated with Gold Rush Era information, probably derived from ships rounding Cape Horn, in 1852.

## **Detailed Condition:**

Nautical chart, old (probably original) canvas backing. Some minor soiling, as should be expected.
