

### **Description:**

Antique engraving of two Dutch East India Company settlements in the Spice Islands: Ambon and Fort Belgica on Banda Neira.

Fort Belgica was an important fort in the area for centuries, originally starting as a Portuguese installation in the 16th century. A volcano is depicted erupting nearby, throwing boulders and knocking down trees.

The engraving was page 475 from *Newe Welt und Americanische Historien* by Johann Ludwig Gottfried, published by Mattaeus Merian, Frankfurt, 1631.
