

## **Description:**

Rare, separately-issued, circa 1885 photolithographed copy of an 18th-century survey of the Upper West Side of Manhattan. The present map incorporates the work of two of Manhattan's greatest surveyors: Casimir Goerck and Joseph Bridges.

The map shows the north portion of the Upper West Side, including some of what is now Central Park, and it extends to the Hudson River in the west. It is bounded in the south by 99th Street and in the north by 107th street.
