

Jews, Egyptians, and Chinese. Another "stream" is given over to the discoveries and progress of civilization.

The hand-coloring is original publisher's color.

Maker attribution is based on two other charts that we have had by Hocquart; all three came in the same collection, are engraved and hand-colored in the same manner, on the same paper. Édouard Hocquart (1789-1870?) was a French mapmaker and engraver active in the first half of the 19th century. He was responsible for several other attractive time maps.

Seemingly not in BNF.

#### **Detailed Condition:**

On three sheets, joined. Bottom edge is a little rough, with short tears into image. Bottom sheet evenly toned, more so than others.
