Rare double-page engraved map of the Loire River watershed, focusing on Anjou.

Pierre Du Val (1619-83) was born in Abbeville, France. He was the nephew of the well-known geographer and cartographer Nicolas Sanson (1600-1667). After moving to Paris with the encouragement of Louis XIV, he became *géographe (ordinaire) du Roi* in 1650. After his death in 1683, Du Val's business was carried on by his widow and daughters.
