Description:

Nice example of Rossi's 4 sheet map of the Lazio region, including Rome, first published in 1693.

The map shows the Lazio territory from Rome to Circeo, with incredible detail. Drawn and engraved by Giacomo Filippo Ameti. The cartouche in the upper left of the first table shows allegories of Tiber and Roma.

After the expansion of Rome, Pope Alexander VII assigned to Francesco Eschinardi, an Italian mathematician and Philosopher, and a member of the Pontifical Academy of Sciences, the task of overseeing the map Agro-Romano Regions, . The map is largely drawn from the work of Innocenzo Mattei, a papal geographer under Clement X, in 1666, with revisions in the coastal regions.

The map is dedicated to Cardinal Pietro Ottoboni.
