Rare French map of Ceylon, from the Celebrated Nouvelles Annales des Voyages.

Engraved folding map from volume XVI of the *Nouvelles Annales des Voyages*, an important French serial issued throughout the first half of the 19th century, describing and illustrating contemporary exploration.

Volume XVI was issued by J. B. Eyries and Conrad Malte-Brun in 1822. It contained a translation of the travels of Dr. John-Davy, member of the Royal Society of London, into the interior of Ceylon (modern-day Sri Lanka).

John Davy MD FRS FRSE (24 May 1790 - 24 January 1868) was a Cornish doctor, amateur chemist, and brother of the noted chemist Sir Humphry Davy, and cousin of Edmund Davy. His work, *An Account of the Interior of Ceylon, and of Its Inhabitants: With Travels in that Island*, was published in London in 1821.
