#### Description:

Scarce map of Mexico, Upper California and contiguous parts of the Southeastern US, naming Texas, but pre-dating its republic period.

The present map is the first edition of Lizar's map, which in a later edition would name the "Republic of Texas." The map also bears a note stating: *Note . . . The boundary between Mexico on the north and the United States is a line drawn from Cape Mendocino, (Lat. 40° 28' 40") Eastward to the Rocky Mountains. Mines indicated by cross, thus +.*

A fine detailed map, which is quite scarce on the market.
