Fine detailed map of the island of Santa Domingo and neighboring islands, published by D'Anville.

Excellent detail throughout includes realistic depictions of bays, mountains, islets, lagoons, forests, etc., which are combined with details of human development of the flourishing colony. Each town, plantation house, windmill, watermill, and sugar works is indicated.

The map includes attribution to Amédée-François Frézier (1682 - 1773), a French military engineer, mathematician, spy, and explorer. In 1719, Frézier returned to the New World as Engineer-in-Chief to Hispaniola (Santo Domingo) on a two-year assignment to fortify the island. He made a map of the island, and also a plan of the City of Santo Domingo.
