

Detailed regional map, centered on the Straits of Singapour, and extending to Pyas De Siak, Tronganon, Mallacca, Mt. Perac, and the Natuna Islands. A few minor wormholes, but no loss of image to the map. A good example of this early and highly detailed regional map. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
