The map provides a highly detailed picture of the routes and roads through the region.

The place names and details in the Gulf region are of interest.

- Qatar is still called El Bahrein, with Hawar Island called Warden's Island.
- Manama is identified on the Island of Bahrain.
- The islands off the coast of Doha, Al Aaliya Island and Al Safilya Island are named (Alli & Sufflie).
- Abu Dhabi (Abu Thubee) is shown, as is Sharjah (Shardya)
