

Highly detailed regional map of Louisiana, Mississippi and Alabama and neighboring regions, published shortly after Missississippi and Alabama were split into seperate Territories of the United States.

Arkansas is not yet named and only a few early roads and settlements are shown.

The northern portion of Mississippi is still largely Indian lands. Early county configurations throughout. One of the best regional maps of the period published outside the United States.

Highly detailed map of the region from Vandermaelen's *Atlas Universel*, the first atlas to systematically map the world in uniform scale. The map is a testament to the phenomenal effort Vandermaelen undertook to compile contemporary and highly detailed information from all parts of the world. A scarce and highly desirable map.
