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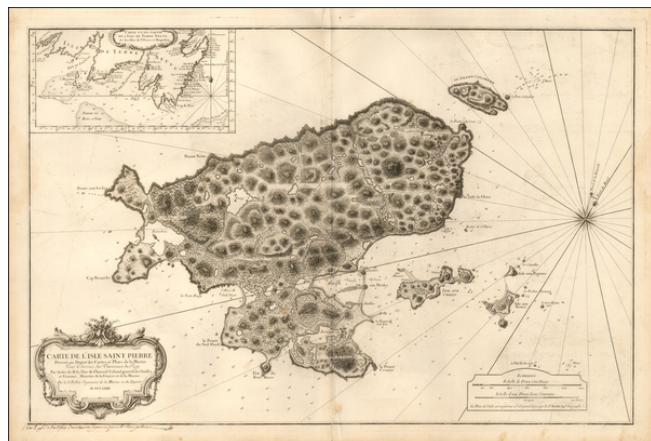

Detailed sea chart of Saint Pierre, one of the small islands in the Grand Banks retained by France under the Treaty of 1783.

The chart was produced by the Depot de la Marine toward the end of the Seven Years War (French & Indian War) .

Following the conclusion of the Seven Years' War, the Treaty of Paris provided that Britain transfer the islands of St. Pierre and Miquelon to France. The French were also granted fishing rights along Newfoundland's shores and Grand Banks.
