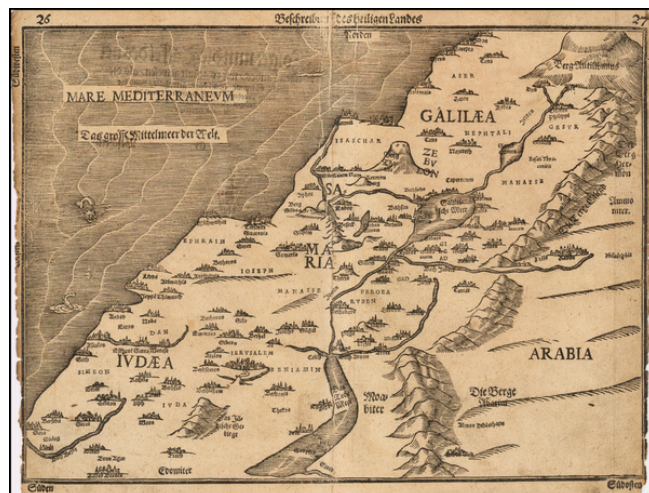

The map shows the 12 tribes of Israel and extends from Gaza and Moab to the mountains north of the source of the Jordan River.

This scarce map is from Heinrich Bunting's *Itinerarum Sacrae Scripturae*. It is believed that more than 60 editions of Bunting's *Itinerarum* were published in various languages between 1581 and 1757. Bunting's work describes the travels of figures in the Bible and was the most complete summary of geography of the Bible of this period. *Itinerarum Sacrae Scripturae* was first printed in Helmstadt in 1581 and was produced in numerous editions in Germany. The book was so popular, it was also issued with text in Danish, Swedish, Dutch, Czech, and English.
