

#### The Approaches To Hong Kong on the eve of World War II

Detailed chart of the area around Hong Kong, published by the British Admiralty in 1936.

First prepared in 1888 and revised on a number of occasions thereafter, the chart extends to Kaipong and the Lema Islands in the south, and Macao Island in the west and Chung Saw Wan in the north.

The revisions and dredging in Kowloon Harbor is shown, with red imprints and a pastedown.

A highly detailed chart of the entrances and approaches to Hong Kong, on the eve of World War II.
