The map shows the positions of the Union Troops in Blue and the Confederate Troops in Red.

The map provides exceptional topographical details of the area around Knoxville. Also shows Fort Sanders, Ft. Dickerson, Ft. Stanley, Fort Hil, Ft. Comstock, Ft. Huntington Smith, Ft. Higley, Battery Billingsley, Battery Noble, Battery Fearns, Battery Steadman, Battery Clifton Sec, Battery Zoellner, the Barracks on the Holston River, roads, the Military Bridge, railroads, etc. Scale of 3 inches to 1 mile.
