

A rare American chart of the coast of Brazil, published by the Blunt firm in 1828.

The map features insets of the Harbor of Sta. Catharina, Cananea, Rio Janeiro, Harbor of Santos, Harbor of Marambaia, Harbor of Port Frio, and the Harbor of Paranagua.

This example of the map was separately issued. The map also appears in the extremely rare collection of charts by the Blunt's charts of the north and south Atlantic oceans, the coast of North and South America, and the West Indies (New York, 1830), see Phillips 3661.
