

Shows Spanish Trail, Cooke's Wagon Route, Kearney's Route, Lewis & Clarke's Canoe Route, Oregon Route, early roads, towns, Indian Tribes, mining claims, etc. An imprortant early map, the first map of the West to appear in an American atlas after the Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo brought California into the Union. New Mexico is merely a narrow sliver of land along the Rio Grande.
