

Description:

The First Admiralty Charting of the Singapore Strait

Important early chart of the waterways southwest of the Strait of Singapore, published by the British Admiralty.

The chart is part of a set of 3 maps of the Strait, published in 1855, primarly based upon the survey work of John Turnbull Thomson, although the present chart credits earlier surveys by Colinoson and Moresby in 1822 and the Dutch Navy in 1843.

Rarity

The chart is very rare. We note only the example in the British Library, National Maritime Museum and National Archives of Singapore.

Detailed Condition:
