Description:

Fine sea chart of the Southernmost coasts of South America, published in Madrid by the Spanish Hydrographical Department.

Rare Spanish chart derived from the voyage of Malaspina and shows the tracks of his ships.

The chart shows the exploration of the coastline of Argentina and Patagonia between 1789 and 1795 by



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the Spanish Royal Navy, providing significant new details along a coastline which is still somewhat incomplete along the parts of the Patagonia Coastline, Tierra del Fuego, etc.

Rarity

The chart is very rare, with only 1 example appearing at auction and again in a dealer catalog listed by AMPR in the past 30 years (Warren Heckrotte Copy, sold by PBA Galleries in 2015 to Martayan Lan).
