



Striking example of the map of Peru from John Ogilby's Complete History of America.

The map extends from Los Pastos in the west to Talvera and Yuntas and Atacama in the east and provides a marvelous, if primitive, look at the Cordilleras, towns, and rivers along the coastline. Embellished with two large cartouches, a sea monster, and sailing ships, plus a compass rose. One of the most decorative early maps of Peru, then the richest part of the Spanish Empire in the New World.
