

Description:

Flawless example of this virtually obtainable map, which appeared in the extremely rare Atlas of the United States. The map was derived from the momumental and equally rare wall map, an historic collaboration between Professor Rogers, and American, and the Johnston publishing house in Britain. The map shows Kansas extending from The Rocky Mountains and Continental Divide to Missouri, including much of modern day Colorado, including South Pass, Pike's Peak and the South Fork of the Platte River. The Pueblofde S. Carlos and Mineral Springs are noted, but not Denver. The map shows a number of early roads, Indian Lands, forts, mountains, springs, rivers, etc. An area in Kansas reserved for the New York Indians and Shawnees are shown. Substantial coverage in Nebraska as well. This interesting and highly coveted map has not appeared in a dealer catalogue in the past 20 years. An essential map for regional collectors.
