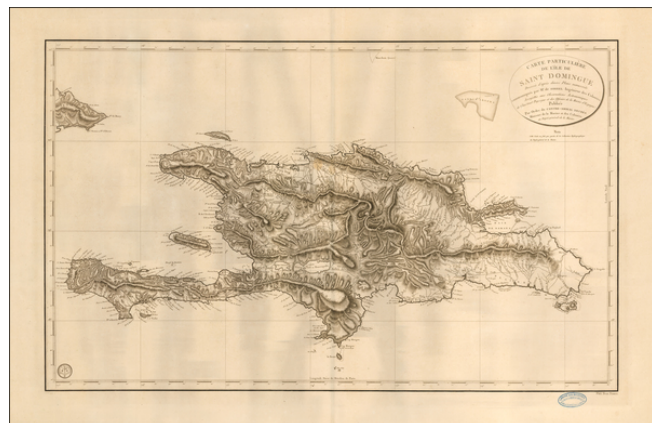

Description:

Fine sea chart of Hispaniola, published by the French Depot de la Marine.

The map is based upon the work of Antoine-François Sorrel des Revières and Antoine-Hyacinthe-Anne de Chastenet de Puysegur.

Antoine Sorrel Des Revieres, rose to the Colonel of Engineers in the French Army, and afterwards held sugar plantation estates in San Domingo, from which he was driven by the slave insurrections in the early part of the nineteenth century. He then moved to Louisiana. His son, Francis Sorrel, became a successful business man in Savannah, Georgia. His grandson would go on to serve as a Confederate General.
