

Description:

One of the earliest printed maps of the island of Barbados, from one of the late editions of John Ogilby's *America*, one of the most influential English works on America published in the 17th Century.

The map identifies Plantation owners, towns, bays, rivers and includes vignettes showing the indigenous crops, including a Cabbage Tree, Indian Corn, Pineapple Tree, Sugar Cane, and a sugar mill.

Decorative cartouches, rhumb lines, sailing ships and compass roses complete the image.
