Striking map of America, exhibiting contemporary discoveries throughout. Excellent Northwest Coast of America including discoverers notes. The Mississippi and Missouri are searching to the west for sources. Odd Gulf Coast and Florida projection. Baja California is based upon Consag. South America has assumed a slimmer shape, but is still barely known in the interior.
