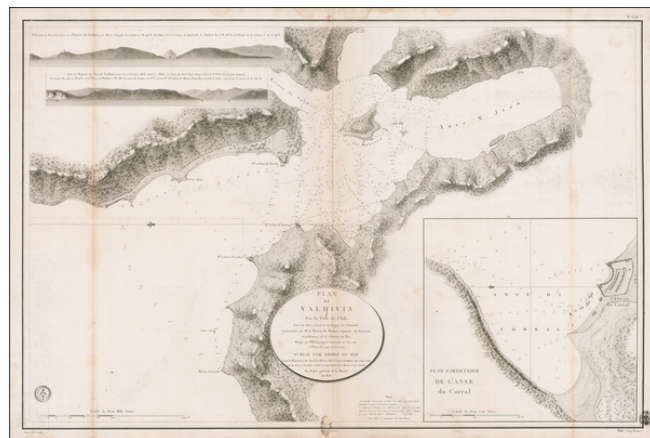

Description:

Finely detailed map of the area around Valdivia, from Volume 7 of the Neptune Francois.

Finely detailed sea chart covering the entrance to Corral Bay and the Valdivia estuary, situated to the southwest of the city of Valdivia, Chile. The map illustrated Mancera Island ("Ile Mansera"), Fort Niebla, Fort St. Carlos, Fort d'Amargos, and St Jean Bay. Includes profile views of the coastline at the entrance to Valdivia River.

The sea chart is drawn from surveys in 1822 by Lieutenant Lartigue and Ensign Flury aboard frigate *la Clorinde*, commissioned by Baron Mackau.

Volume 7 of Neptune Francois (volume title *Neptune des cotes occidentales d'Amerique sur le Grand Ocean*.) forms an extensive atlas of charts of the western coasts of North and South America, with most charts dated or updated to the 1820's.
