



## **Description:**

Fine example of Bellin's map of Georgia, from Bellin's *La Petit Atlas Maritime*, one of the earliest obtainable separate maps of the Colony of Georgia.

Extends from Port Royal and Augusta in the north to Saint Augustin in the south. Shows a number of early roads, Fort More, Ft. Argyll, F. du Roi George, F. Diego, F Picolata, Ebenezer and Old Ebenezer, Savannah, Fort S. Georges, etc. The 1738 Georgia-Florida boundary line is also shown.

One of the earliest obtainable maps of the region.
