Rare map of Minorca, with large views of Mahon, published in London by Laurie & Whittle.

The map has four large insets, including:

- North Prospect of Mahon
- North East Prospect of ST. Philips Castle
- Mahon Harbor
- Spanish Coastline

Major-General John Armstrong (1674-1742) was responsible for overseeing the improvement of the fortifications in Minorca in anticipation of a British War with Spain. He wrote a detailed description of the island, including natural history, political history, topography, etc. His book, first published in 1752 and re-issued at the outset of the Sevn Years' War, was an important source of information for informing the British public.
