***Early State of Edward Stanford's Wall Map of South America***

Nice example of Edward Stanford's large format library map of South America.

In the early 1850s Edward Stanford commissioned Alexander Keith Johnston to prepare a set of large wall maps of each of the 6 continents: Europe; Australasia; Asia; Africa; North America; and South America. Johnston's wall maps, which Stanford titled "Library Maps" became one of the most enduring works of the period, issued continuously with updates well into the 20th Century.
