This is one of the earliest obtainable maps of the island.

The map names many plantations, bays and the numerous the smaller islands surrounding Saint Thomas including Lille Saba.

The map appeared in Oldendorp's "History of the Evangelical Brethren on the Caribbean Islands of St. Thomas, St. Croix and St. John," the earliest printed history of the Virgin Islands.
