A nice full color example of Speed's map of the world, based upon William Grent's map of 1625. This is one of the earliest attainable world maps printed in English. The map shows California as an Island, an unusual NW Coast of America, conjectural Magellanica or The Southerne Unknowne Land and extraordinary early detail throughout the map. It is surrounded by smaller celestial hemispheres, figural representations of Water, Earthe, Aire and Fire, a number of celestial phenomena & portraits of early explorers. Includes several lengthy notes on the South Pole & Straits of Magellan. Faint printer's crease at centerfold, else excellent full color example, with nice full margins and fine hand coloring. The 1651 edition is one of the rarer editions of the map.
