Engraved map of the United States, published in the *European Magazine*, by John Fielding, in 1783 the year that the United States was recognized by the United Kingdom.

The map was subsequently published in John Andrews' *History of the War with America, France, Spain, and Holland* in 1785, with the date changed. This is the first state.

The map takes particular care to render the maritime limits of the territory of the United States, shown with a dotted line in the Atlantic.

The map features an unusual Maine-Canada border.

Forts and Indian tribes are labeled west of the Appalachian Mountains.
