

The map attribution is quite ironic, given that two of the most famous mapmakers of modern history were named John Smith (British Explorer of the early 17th Century and British Geologist of the mid-19th Century).

The map was published in *Traveller's Joy A Device*, written by Dion Clayton Calthrop and illustrated by Gilbert Pownall.
