

Large scale map of the region west of the Mississippi River, showing the exploration routes of Gunnison and Beckwith for the Pacific Railroad Survey, across Missouri, Kansas, Colorado, Utah, and into California.

The map was issued in the first year of the existence of Kasa Territory and Nebraska Territory.

The map exhibits two of the earliest government surveys in the region, in search of the most practicable route for the Transcontinental Railroad.
