Description:

Rare separately published map of Manhattan, published in 1908.

Issued four years after the first New York Subway was opened in 1904, the map shows a remarkable picture of the growth of the subway lines, which now extend north across all of Manhattan in two lines.

A key at the bottom notes:



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- Subway Lines and Tunnels completed (solid red line)
- Subway Lines under Construction (broken red line)
- Elevated Railroads (checked line)
- Surface Car Lines (dashed line)

Locates the Brooklyn Bridge, Manhattan Bridge, East River Bridge, Blackwell's Island Bridge, several tunnels across the Hudson and many other details.
