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

Second edition of Samuel Augustus Mitchell's separately published map of Virginia and Maryland (with a large inset of Washington DC).

The map is hand colored by counties and names early towns, roads, mountains, rivers, etc. Includes a large early inset map of Washington DC.

At the top left are 3 tables organized by counties, providing a breakdown of "Whites, Free Black & Slave" populations for Virginia, Maryland and the District of Columbia (by city).

One of the first large format maps of Virginia and Maryland to appear in an American Atlas--this example appearing in a rare pocket edition of Mitchell's atlas.
