

Nice example of Heinrich Bunting's map of the Holy Land, based upon the New Testament.

The map extend from Sidon and the area south of Jerusalem and Bethlehem and the lands on either side of the Jordan River and the Dead Sea.

The major cities are depicted in miniature view form with Jerusalem being the most prominent. P Two sea monsters grace the Mediterranean

This scarce map is from Heinrich Bunting's *Itinerarum Sacrae Scripturae*. It is believed that more than 60 editions of Bunting's *Itinerarum* were published in various languages between 1581 and 1757. Bunting's work describes the travels of figures in the Bible and was the most complete summary of geography of the



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Bible of this period. *Itinerarum Sacrae Scripturae* was first printed in Helmstadt in 1581 and was produced in numerous editions in Germany. The book was so popular, it was also issued with text in Danish, Swedish, Dutch, Czech, and English.
