

Wonderfully detailed map of the region from Lake Timpangos, Lake Teguayo and Rio de los Piramides Sulfareas in the West and extending into modern day Colorado and Wyoming, showing more detail than any other contemporary map. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale. His treatment of the Western US is a landmark in the history the cartography of the Western US, undertaking to map in 20 sheets a region which American publishers were virtually ignoring. A fine unfolded and probably separately issued example of this pair of maps covering the Baja. A bit of spotting and soiling, else an excellent example. Normally a \$750.00 map.
