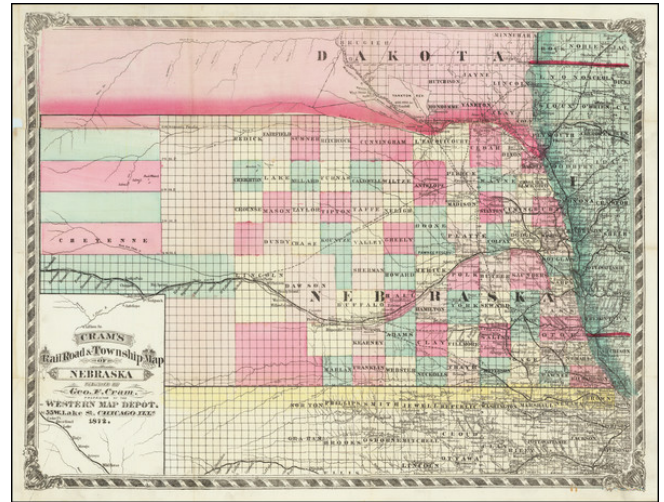

Description:

Rare early railroad map of Nebraska, published by George Cram.

The map is colored by counties and shows the surveyed portions of Nebraska, with some still unsurveyed regions in the west.

A single railroad route (Union Pacific) traverses the state, with a number of actual and proposed lines shown in the eastern half of the state.

George Cram would become one of the most prolific atlas publishers of the last 19th and early 20th Centuries. However, his earliest maps, issued in the late 1860s and early 1870s, were marvelous separately issued railroad maps. His success led to the publication of two editions of his now impossibly rare *Standard American Atlas* in 1875 and 1879, which included a number of Cram's rare separately issued railroad maps.
