

First State!

Nice example of John Arrowsmith's map of the Asiatic Archipelago, including a large inset map of Singapore.

Centered on the Philippines and Borneo, the map shows a number of different seasonal passages through the region to Hong Kong and Macao.

The map comes shortly after the conclusion of the Opium Wars, at a time when trade with Hong Kong and Singapore was growing at a tremendous rate.

The inset of Singapore is accompanied by a lengthy annotation, describing "Singapore being granted to the British by the Sultan of Jehor on 1819... as well as the Seas, Straits, and Islands lying within 10 miles of its coasts", and concluding with the observation that "The chief importance of Singapore is as a commercial emporium."
