The map is intended to illustrate the expedition of Ferdinand de Soto in 1534, based upon his original accounts.

This is a deluxe edition of the map, with the extra picture frame border. It is made even more desirable by this rare bit of ephemera, a letter from Walter Ristow, the long time head of the Geography & Map Division of the Library of Congress.
