This is an image of the earth, taken during the trans-lunar injection of the Apollo 10 spacecraft. North America is clearly visible from Los Angeles to the Gulf of Alaska. In California, the Central Valley gives way to a snowy Sierra Nevada, with the Basin and Range Province dry. The long peninsula of Baja California is clearly visible. The Pacific Northwest is, somewhat unsurprisingly, overcast and covered with clouds, clearing near Vancouver. The Canadian and Alaskan Coast Ranges are visible. To the east, Texas and the Gulf of Mexico are visible, with a cloudy Appalachia and New England.
