Includes roads, towns, counties, Indian Trails, Connelly's Trail, Proposed Pacific RR Route, Smith & Whitney's Route, the Route to Ft. Smith, Loredo Road, Upper Presidio Road, Lower Presidio Road, etc.

Many forts and other places of interest are shown. Large insets of Sabine Lake and Galveston area.

One of the first maps to show all of Texas, without insets of the Northern or Western portions of the map.
