The map shows streets, buildings, train lines, public places, rivers etc.

The map differentiates between "steam railroads" and "horse railroads". Queens Park is shown along with the "New Provincial Parliament Buildings" many other landmark buildings are shown and labeled.

Cram was one of the pre-eminent American Mapmakers of the late 19th Century, relying upon a cerographic printing process first applied to maps by the Morse family in the late 1830s, which ultimately led to the demise of the hand-colored map.
