

Description:

Fine large British sea chart of the Southern California Coastline, published in 1928, with small corrections to 1957.

The chart extends from San Diego to Point Conception and Arguello Point, centered on Santa Monica and the LA Basin. Offshore islands include Catalina, the Channel Islands and San Clemente Island.

Includes a large town plan of Santa Monica.

The map is highly detailed, showing soundings, lighthouses, and some topographical details and railroads. The focus on lighted air fields is also quite interesting.

A scarce nautical chart-this is the first example of the map we have ever seen for any date.
