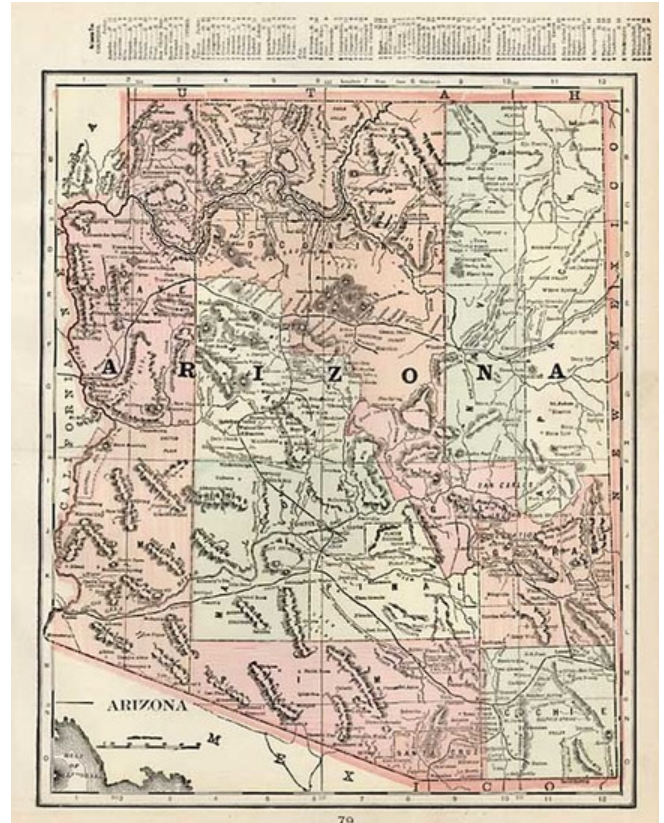

Detailed map of the state, colored by Counties, showing Indian Reservations, forts, Military Reserves, mines, forests, towns, railroads, railroad stations, post offices, rivers, forts and other places of interest. A nice late 19th Century map, printed using the Cerographic printing process which was invented by the Morse Family in the 1830s and which ultimately revolutionized the map making industry in the 1880s through such firms as Cram and Rand McNally & Co.
