***Rare Theodorus Danckerts Imprint***

Old color example of Danckerts map of Asia and the northern part of Australia, called Hollandia Nova.

The map extends north to the unknown coasts of Yesso and includes an interesting projection of Japan.

Nice detail in China, including naming Formosa. Several place names on the northern Australian coast.

The Philippines and Southeast Asian landmasses are disproportionately large, with the surrounding seas much smaller than actual size.

First issued by Justus Danckerts, this example bears the imprint of his son "T[heodorus] Danckerts," a relatively rare imprint.
