Description:

Interesting early map of Mexico and the Southwest, pre-dating the reports of Humboldt & Pike. A single cordillera is shown for the Rocky Mountains. A detailed, if incomplete Lake Timpanagos is shwon. Several of the mythical western rivers are present, but truncated. The course of the Rio Colorado and Gila are relatively accurate for the period. Good detail in Texas and the Plains, especially the courses of the Red River, Arkansas and the Missouri, which is highly inaccurate. An excellent map of the period immediately prior to the extensive exploration of much of this region. Very narrow margins, sometimes touching neatline. Minor dampstain along the left side of the map and one spot.
