

Excellent British Admiralty chart of the Strait of Juan de Fuca, focusing on the San Juan Islands, and also showing Victoria and Vancouver B.C. The chart was originally published in 1882 and was updated numerous times to 1924.

Despite the fact that the chart is largely focused on hydrographic and bathymetric information, it also includes nice renditions of topographical and terrestrial detail, including basic street layouts for Victoria and Vancouver.

Bellingham, Washington is also depicted. Friday Harbor is labeled on San Juan Island.
